Decision

The Public Health Office of Slovak Republic, competent according to Section 18, Paragraph 1, Letter b) of Act No. 272/1994 Coll. adopted by the Slovak National Council, reviewed the application submitted by **Maria Vet Slovakia**, **spol. s.r.o.**, **Jastrabia 4**, **Prešov**, dated 6 June 2004, decided with respect to a decision for the distribution and use of **AQUASTERIL®** products designated for the disinfection of drinking water according to Section 20 Paragraph 3 Letter k) of Act No. 272/1994 Coll.,

as follows:

The application submitted by Maria Vet Slovakia, spol. s.r.o., Prešov, dated 6 June 2004, is acquitted and the distribution and use of **AQUASTERIL®** products, i.e.:

AQUASTERIL 2 – TRAMP AQUASTERIL 20 – CAMP AQUASTERIL 50 – TRIP AQUASTERIL 1000 – CAMP

Manufactured by **AQUA PLUS, s.r.o.**, Prague, designated for the disinfection of drinking water **is hereby approved**.

Justification:

Maria Vet Slovakia, spol. s r.o., Jastrabia 4, Prašov filed an application on 6 June 2004 within the meaning of Section 27 Paragraph 2 Letter i) of Act No. 272/1994 Coll., for the assessment of the environmental impacts of the products specified above. According to the presented documentation including a positive approval by the Principal Health Officer of the Czech Republic, a Test Protocol and the hygiene assessment of the characteristics of **AQUASTERIL®** products, issued by the Regional Hygiene Station for the Central Bohemian Region in Prague, the products meet the requirements laid down in the public health protection regulations and are suitable for the disinfection of drinking water and the emergency preparation of water with permissible microbial characteristics.

Pursuant to what has been said above, the decision was adopted as indicated in the verdict of this Decision. This Decision relates only to products with the contents, properties and use corresponding to the samples presented for assessment.

The presented materials shall be retained for the purpose of archiving.

Appeal:

An appeal may be lodged against this Decision within 15 days following its delivery, to the Public Health Office of Slovak Republic.

This Decision is subject to court revision according to the pertinent provisions of Act 99/1963 Coll., Civil Procedure Code, as amended by subsequent regulations.
